Special Issue on Empirically-Supported
Psychosocial Interventions for Individuals
with Developmental/Intellectual Disabilities and/or Autism**

The *Journal of Mental Health Research in Intellectual Disabilities* requests manuscript submissions for a special issue on empirically-supported psychosocial interventions for individuals with developmental/intellectual disabilities and/or autism. The special issue will feature original empirical outcome studies (single-subject experiments as well as group studies), critical reviews of the evidence-based literature, and conceptual papers central to psychosocial interventions (such as issues affecting the conduct of psychosocial treatment research).

Psychosocial interventions include cognitive, behavioral, and cognitive-behavioral techniques to improve mental concerns. Examples include applied behavior analysis, behavior therapy, cognitive behavior therapy, mindfulness training, Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT), dialectical behavior therapy, psychoeducational groups, and family education and support.

The submission deadline for the *Special Issue on Empirically-Supported Psychosocial Interventions for Individuals with Developmental/Intellectual Disabilities and/or Autism* is January 15, 2012.
